

Instructions for Volunteers

Multnomah Days Westside Watershed Booth - 8/17/2019

Show the person/child the options they have:

Take our Wildlife survey

Report a wildlife observation

Report an idea, like how animals migrate or where they sleep.

Add something to the map.

A. SURVEY CARD: Check off which creatures they have seen in their own yard or nearby.

Instructions: For animals in their yard, use the check list card, help them give their location - their neighborhood name or a near by park. For sightings outside their yard, help place a colored dot on the map (D.)

B. CARD. This would be a Story about an animal they saw or see from time to time, like a deer or raccoon.

Instructions: Have them write their story on a 4x6 card.

C. CARD. Tell us How you suppose animals move from one part of Southwest Portland to another.

Instructions: Name and describe the trail on a 4x6 card. If multiple people report the same animal trail, mark the animal trail (migration path) on the map with DRY ERASE marker. Be sure that the trail is reasonable. i.e that is makes sense. People should tell you how/when/why animals use the trail.

D. ON THE MAP. Place colored dot on the map or Draw a label on the Map using a marker.

Instructions: Mark a known site, like a coyote den, on the map. (Also write a story on a card.)
