

OUR SYSTEM OF STREET RAILWAYS

What the Various City and Suburban Lines Are Doing—All Well Patronized Yesterday

Notwithstanding that Signal Service Officer Pague pronounced the temperature yesterday normal that is the regular thing for this time of year, a great many people thought it uncomfortably cool for the season. In the early morning it was cold enough to snow, and it was dull and gloomy all the forenoon.

The road is now in good condition, the cuts having been cleared out and the fill which was settled by the rains leveled and ballasted. It takes about twenty minutes to run from G street to the south city limits, and cars run from there to the park four times a day during the week and every half hour on Sundays.

A large number patronized the cable road which has been making a splendid record for the past two weeks. Public confidence in the road has been entirely restored and nearly every car went loaded to the heights, where they greatly enjoyed the magnificent view of which none ever appear to weary.
